DB Planter - XP Row Unit - Seed Firmer Instructions

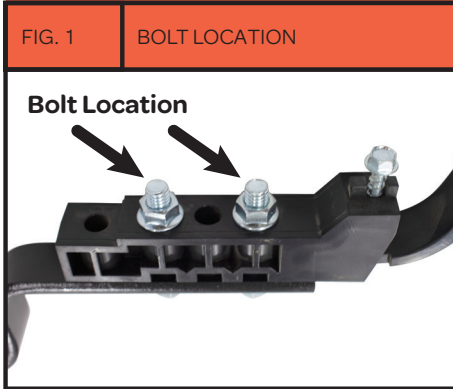


Fig. 1 Above highlights the bolt location for Firmer block. Connect using 2 Standard Hex Bolts in the 2nd and 4th hole openings.¹

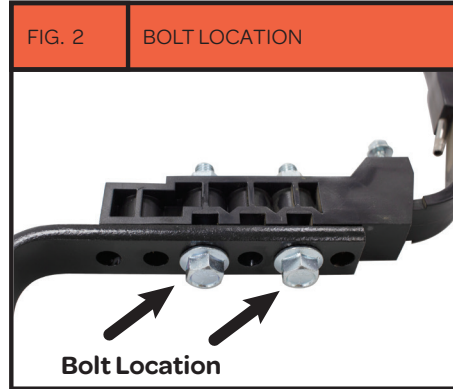


Fig 2 Above highlights the bolt location for the Firmer block and S Bar. Connect using 2 Standard Hex Bolts in the 3rd and 5th hole openings.¹

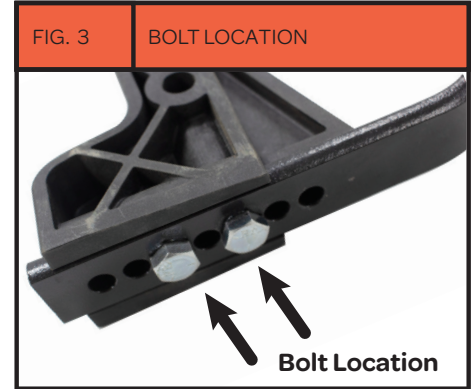


Fig3 Above highlights the bolt location for the Firmer block and the S Bar. Place the bolts in the 3rd and 5th hole openings.¹

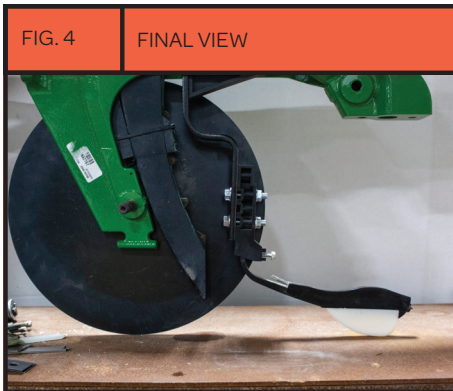


Fig. 4 Final view of attached piece.
